Diana J. Schwerha is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering at Ohio University. She earned her doctorate in Industrial and Management Systems Engineering from West Virginia University. Dr. Schwerha's research interests focus on: 1) improving the safety, productivity, and job satisfaction of aging workers, 2) applying human factors interventions to retain employees, and 3) using ergonomics to enable older individuals to live independently. Before coming to Ohio University, she worked as a project officer for NIOSH at the Health Effects Laboratory Division and the Pittsburgh Research Laboratory.

1. Nomination Form
2. Endorsement Form

- a. Current Job Description and organization chart depicting the safety function.
- b. Sponsors description of the scope and quality of the nominee's job related duties and achievements and other safety related activities. (has to be on organization stationery)

3. Petition

- a. Submit **one (1)** electronic version of the petition to Hal Williams.
- b. A picture of the candidate is not required for petition submittal to the ROC SPY Committee.

4. The Region SPY Recipient is required to submit a picture to both the Region SPY Committee and Society.

- a. The picture along with a brief bio of the SPY Recipient will be posted on the Region VII web-site.
- b. Society will use the picture for the PDC program and award during the PDC
